# About ORX Cyber

## What is ORX Cyber?

ORX Cyber is a subscription service designed for second line cyber and information security risk professionals across the global financial sector. It provides access to structured, industry sourced cyber event data, control benchmarking, peer collaboration and forward looking research.

The service enables firms to strengthen cyber oversight, validate their risk management approach and remain aligned with evolving supervisory expectations.

Through a secure and anonymised data exchange and an active practitioner community, ORX Cyber supports informed decision making, credible benchmarking and defensible cyber risk management practice.

## Who can become an ORX Cyber subscriber?

ORX Cyber is open to financial institutions operating in banking, insurance and asset management that maintain a dedicated second line cyber or information security risk function.

Subscribing institutions contribute anonymised cyber event data under the [Cyber Operational Risk Reporting Standards](#) on a structured give to get basis. Data is shared securely via ORX's data exchange platform and is quality assured to ensure consistency and comparability.

The service is designed specifically for second line oversight, creating a trusted, practitioner led environment focused on cyber risk governance and challenge.

An anonymised, industry sourced database of cyber and information security risk events submitted by financial institutions. It enables benchmarking of event trends, impacts, threat actors and control gaps using structured peer data.
